

ERIE Plan Change Effective 1/1/26

GLP-1 medications prescribed for weight loss (e.g., Wegovy, Zepbound and Saxenda) will have a 30% co-insurance, with no out-of-pocket max. If you are currently prescribed this medication, you can review actual past claim costs by navigating to **Claims & Accounts > My claims on myuhc.com**.

Average Potential Drug Cost:

- Zepbound - \$1021.58
- Wegovy \$1284.32

To assist in the transition, we encourage you to visit the drug manufacturer websites as it is commonplace to be able to leverage available coupons in conjunction with your insurance to further offset this expense.

For Health Plan 1 and 2:

- Effective 1/1/26, you will pay 30% of the total cost of your medication, with no out-of-pocket max.

For CDHP (Consumer Directed Health Plan):

- Effective 1/1/26 if you have not met your deductible, you will pay full cost for the drug until the deductible is satisfied. Once satisfied, you will pay 30% of the total amount of the medication, without accumulation to your out of pocket.
